Technical Education – Announcement 2015-16 under Rule 110 – Establishment of Five New Government Polytechnic Colleges at Chennai, Dharmapuri, Thiruvavur, Thanjavur and Krishnagiri Districts– Administrative Sanction for opening of Colleges, sanction of recurring & non-recurring expenditure and sanction of teaching & non-teaching Posts and administrative sanction for building cost – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Legislative Assembly on 25-09-2015, the Hon'ble Chief Minister had made the following announcement, under the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rule 110 :-

“தமிழ்நாட்டில் உள்ள பின்தங்கிய மாவட்டங்களில் உள்ள கிராமப்புற மாணவர்கள் மற்றும் மாணவிகள் தொழில்நுட்பக் கல்வி பெற வழிவகை செய்யப்பட்டுள்ளது. மேலும், அரசு பலவகைத் தொழில்நுட்பக் கல்லூரிகள் இல்லாத இடங்களில், இத்தகைய கல்லூரிகளைத் துவங்குவதன் மூலம் மாணவர்கள் மற்றும் மாணவிகள் நீண்ட தூரம் பயணம் செய்து கல்வி பயிலும் நிலை தவிர்க்கப்பட்டு, அவர்கள் தொழில்நுட்பக் கல்வி பெற இயலும். பின்தங்கிய பகுதிகளைச் சேர்ந்த மாணவர்கள் மற்றும் மாணவிகள் தொழில்நுட்பக் கல்வி பெற்று வேலைவாய்ப்பு பெற இது வழிவகுக்கும். எனவே, 5 புதிய அரசு பலவகை தொழில்நுட்பக் கல்லூரிகள் 150 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் துவங்கப்படும்”.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Technical Education has sent a detailed proposal, containing the details of i) requirement of land, ii) courses to be offered, iii) cost estimate for construction of buildings, iv) purchase of equipment, computers, furniture and library books & e-journals, v) sanction of post (both teaching & non-teaching) and (vi) recurring expenditure for teaching & non-teaching staff salary, for the establishment of Five New Government Polytechnic Colleges in the State and requested the Government to accord financial sanction of Rs.23890 lakh and sanction of posts for establishment of 5 New Government Polytechnic Colleges, as detailed below :-

3. The Government after careful examination, accord administrative sanction for starting of following Five New Government Polytechnic Colleges with the five courses, viz., Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering and Computer Engineering with sanctioned intake of 60 for each course :-

4. The Government also sanctioned 18 teaching and 20 non-teaching, 12 Technical Posts and 11 basic servant posts for each College for first year, as detailed in the Annexure to this order, subject to filling the basic servant posts, except Office Assistant by outsourcing and sanction Rs. 17.86 crore (Rupees seventeen crore and eighty six lakh only) (Rs 3.57 crore per Polytechnic College) towards recurring expenditure for teaching / non-teaching staff for first year for 5 Government Polytechnic Colleges.

5. The Government also sanction a sum of Rs.2.50 crore (Rupees Two crore and fifty lakh only) (Rs. 50.00 lakh per Polytechnic College) as non-recurring expenditure for procurement of the following items required for the first academic year for 5 Government Polytechnic Colleges.

6. The Government also accord administrative sanction for Rs.25.66 crore (Rupees twenty five crore and sixty six lakh only) towards construction of buildings at the scheduled rate for 2015-16 for each Government Polytechnic College.

7. The Director of Technical Education shall appoint an expert from among the Senior Heads of Department from the Government Polytechnic Colleges as Special Officer to co-ordinate the activities for getting the approval of AICTE at an early date.

8. The expenditure sanctioned at para 4, 5 & 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 - 6 above constitutes an item of "New Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due courses. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Technical Education is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. She is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-16 to Finance (BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.




