## ABSTRACT

Higher Education – Enhancement of consolidated remuneration for Full time Temporary Faculty on contract basis in Government Polytechnic Colleges and Government Engineering Colleges – Guest Lecturers in Government Arts and Science Colleges and Government College of Education – Orders - Issued.

### ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, Orders have been issued to fill up 1531 vacant Teaching Posts in the Government Engineering Colleges (220 posts) and Government Polytechnic Colleges (1311 posts) by the respective Principals by appointing full time temporary lecturers on contract basis under consolidated remuneration of Rs.15,000/- per month, instead of appointing part-time lecturers on hourly basis, until all vacant sanctioned posts are completely filled up by the Teachers Recruitment Board and a sum of Rs.2526.15 lakh have been sanctioned towards remuneration for the faculty to be appointed.

2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued revising the payment of Guest Lecturers working under the control of Directorate of Collegiate Education from Rs.15,000/- per month to Rs.20,000/- per month from 01.01.2020 onwards.

3. In the letter third read above, the Director of Technical Education has sent a proposal for revision of consolidated pay to the Temporary Assistant Professors / Lecturers in all the Government Engineering and Government Polytechnic Colleges and has stated as follows:-

- i) There are 702 posts in 51 Government Polytechnic Colleges and 347 posts in 10 Government Engineering Colleges which are lying vacant and the college wise breakup details of Posts sanctioned, filled and vacant are furnished.

- ii) The revision of consolidated pay is necessary in Engineering and Polytechnic Colleges to resolve the imbalance between the consolidated pay of Rs.20,000/- sanctioned for Guest Lecturers in Government Arts and Science Colleges. The minimum qualification prescribed for Engineering College Assistant Professor is higher than the minimum qualification prescribed for Polytechnic College Lecturer. So with difference in revision of pay to the temporary faculties working in Government Engineering and Polytechnic Colleges is recommended as Rs.25,000/- and Rs.20,000/- per month respectively.
- iii) With the above pay revision request, the total Annual Recurring expenditure of Rs.2498.65 lakhs is required towards remuneration for Assistant Professors / Temporary Lecturers of 1049 vacant posts in both 10 Government Engineering Colleges and 51 Government Polytechnic Colleges as per the details furnished below:-

- iv) The Director of Technical Education has also stated that, it is mandatory to get the approval of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) every year to admit students in all Engineering and Polytechnic Colleges and in order to obtain Extension of Approval (EOA) from AICTE every year, it is very much essential to fill up the vacant teaching posts periodically in order to maintain the faculty student ratio of 1:15 for Engineering Colleges and 1:20 for Polytechnic Colleges to fulfill the faculty requirements as per AICTE norms.

4. Therefore, the Director of Technical Education has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the following:-

- a) To grant permission for appointment of Temporary Faculty (Assistant Professor for Government Engineering Colleges and Lecturers for Government Polytechnic Colleges) at consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- per month for all Government Engineering Colleges and Rs.20,000/- per month for all Government Polytechnic Colleges at all vacant posts by the respective Principals for a period of 11 months every year as an interim measure until all the vacant posts are completely filled up by the Teachers Recruitment Board.
- b) To sanction a sum of Rs.15,44,40,000/- as recurring expenditure towards consolidated remuneration for Government Polytechnic Colleges and also sanction a sum of Rs.9,54,25,000/- as recurring expenditure towards consolidated remuneration for Government Engineering Colleges under appropriate Head of Account.
- c) To permit the respective Principals of all Institutions to fill up the subsequent vacancies created due to retirement, transfer etc., apart from the current vacant posts as mentioned above.

5. In the letters fourth read above, the Director of Collegiate Education has stated that 7374 (Shift-I – 5713 & Shift-II – 1661) posts of Guest Lecturers have been sanctioned so far to the Government Arts and Science Colleges, Government Colleges of Education (inclusive of Constituent Colleges converted as Government Colleges and 06 posts of Guest Lecturers sanctioned to the course started for hearing impaired students at Presidency College) for Shift-I and Shift-II. She has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.202,78,50,000/- for 11 months (April 2023 and June 2023 to March 2024) and permission for appointment of Guest Lecturers with consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- per month.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Technical Education and the Director of Collegiate Education and decided to accept the same and accordingly, orders the following, subject to the conditions already stipulated in this regard:-

- i) Consolidated remuneration is enhanced from Rs.15,000/- to Rs.25,000/- per month for the full time temporary faculty on contract basis of all Government Engineering Colleges, from Rs.15,000/- to Rs.20,000/- per month for the full time temporary faculty on contract basis of all Government Polytechnic Colleges and from Rs.20,000/- to Rs.25,000/- per month for the Guest Lecturers (both Shift-I & Shift-II) in all Government Arts and Science Colleges / Government Colleges of Education with effect from June 2023 for 11 months in a year excluding the month of May.

- ii) The Director of Technical Education is permitted to fill up the balance of vacant teaching posts out of the identified 347 vacant teaching posts (i.e 183 posts) in the Government Engineering Colleges and to fill the balance vacant posts out of the identified 702 vacant teaching posts in the Government Polytechnic Colleges (i.e 224 posts) by the respective Principals by appointing full time temporary faculty on contract basis under the consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- per month for all Government Engineering Colleges and Rs.20,000/- per month for all Government Polytechnic Colleges for the existing full time temporary faculty on contract basis and the full time temporary faculty on contract basis to be appointed, until all vacant sanctioned posts are completely filled up by the Teachers Recruitment Board and also sanction a sum of Rs.24,98,65,000/- towards remuneration of the above staff. The expenditure in this regard shall be met from the existing budget provision.
- iii) The Director of Collegiate Education is directed to fill up the remaining 322 vacant post of Guest Lecturers in the Government Arts and Science Colleges and Government Colleges of Education, for which Sanction has already been accorded in G.O. (D) No.195, Higher Education (G1) Department, dated 21.06.2023 under the consolidated remuneration of Rs.25,000/- per month and the Government also sanction a sum of Rs.40,55,70,000/- (Rupees Forty Crore Fifty Five Lakh and Seventy Thousand only) towards additional remuneration for the Guest Lecturers.
